I also liked talking about other people's favorite films and video games, and I even watched a film that one girl recommended to me. I also liked writing a post about the war in Ukraine, and I think that the whole world should know about it. And at the last one, I really liked the conference, because it was an opportunity to communicate with the creator of the project, as well as with other participants.

Elina: Participation in this project led to a significant development of my skills and the acquisition of valuable experience. Firstly, this project improved my writing skills. I learned how to express my thoughts clearly and expressively became a key element of my written expression. Secondly, participating in the project developed my communication skills.
