INFORMATION SHEET

Comics have been a beloved form of storytelling for decades, enthralling readers with their unique blend of visual art and storytelling. Comics have also gained recognition as a means of exploring complex social issues and combating stereotypes. Requirements:

1. Create comics on the topic of “ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE: PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE” (see the assessment template: https://docs.google.com/document/d/1TD21hVRIfGb0_IaRkkZnW_z5RjJ3--7UwIrCA12RTYY/edit?usp=sharing).
2. Use any convenient tool for creating comics (e.g.: https://www.canva.com/uk_ua/stvorvty/komiksy/).
3. Come up with and write a title for the comic in the center (up to 10 words).
4. Create images that highlight the relevant topic (385-400 words).
5. Save the images and number them in a logical sequence on one file in PDF format. Sign the file as follows: University_Institute/Faculty_Group_Surname_Name (e.g.: KPI_IPhT_FB-21_Petrenko_K_M).
6. Use appropriate vocabulary and grammar.
7. Use colloquial language, abbreviated speech, etc.
8. Perform tasks with the number of performers from 1-2.
9. Fill out the Google form for participation in the contest and consent to posting your creative work on the Internet, on the university website (<https://forms.gle/kZDW9G6fp95s1fKv5>).
